Request for Nominations

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is accepting nominations for participation in a Humboldt Working Group to support the PG&E Humboldt WaveConnect™ pilot project. The WaveConnect team seeks individuals who will be committed to successfully achieving the roles and responsibilities outlined below. Please submit your nominations by June 5, 2009.

WaveConnect Humboldt Working Group Responsibilities

Members of the Humboldt Working Group will:

- Provide local area expertise, knowledge, and any topics of interest to inform the development of a license application, navigation plan, biological assessment, adaptive management plan and monitoring plan which will be filed with the Federal Regulatory Commission (FERC) in early 2010.
- Conduct public outreach to constituent groups, including them in the process and keeping them informed of project progress.
- Participate in regular meetings, either in-person or via teleconference. The Working Group will meet on a monthly basis and more frequently if needed. The first meeting will be in July 2009, and the final meeting is anticipated to be held in January 2010. Meetings will take place in a centrally located area in Eureka or Arcata.
- Participate in planning phone calls or additional site visits, as needed.
- Review materials and prepare in advance of Humboldt Working Group meetings.

Criteria for Member Selection

Members of the Humboldt Working Group are expected to have the following attributes:

- Commitment to completing all aspects of the Humboldt Working Group responsibilities.
- Ability to bring first-hand knowledge and perspective related to the environmental, economic, recreational and cultural activities of the region.
- Willingness to express fundamental interests (as opposed to fixed positions) of one or more stakeholder groups.
- Ability to work collaboratively with other stakeholders to integrate the interests of all constituencies and find solutions that work for as many diverse stakeholders as possible.
- Ability to communicate with constituents who are interested in the pilot project to assist in bringing diverse interests to the process and to share Working Group progress with others.

Selection Process

Selection of Humboldt Working Group members will be made by an Ad Hoc committee. The Ad Hoc committee will include representatives of local government, fishing, environmental, economic, community, academic and tribal interests, if possible.

Collectively, the Humboldt Working Group should represent a broad diversity of stakeholder interests, perspectives, and expertise.

The selection of Humboldt Working Group members will be made by July 1, 2009, with the first meeting to be held in July 2009.
