What happens next?

After reviewing the results of the no-cost and no-obligation assessment, you can choose whether or not to proceed. Organizations that decide to make the recommended upgrades may enter into a work order agreement with a qualified contractor and will be responsible for paying costs that are not covered by the Energy Watch incentive. Do-it-yourself and other contractor options are also available.
