**Direct Install Participation Checklist** 

Becoming a Redwood Coast Energy Watch participating Installer has never been easier. Just follow the checklist below to begin.

Review the program manual and the associated processes, standards, policies and conditions of the program.

Confirm you have the minimum insurances required as noted in section 6.D of the program manual.

Add RCEA and PG&E as additionally insured per section 6.D.

Sign the 2019-June 2020 Redwood Coast Energy Watch Installer Certificate found in the Program Manual as Attachment 1 (last page).

Call and ask questions if you would like clarification on any item.

Draft a cover letter with but not limited to the following:

- o Statement of intent to participate,
- o Experience with energy efficiency upgrade projects,
- o Company name, address, contact information,
- Contractor's license number.
