ADDENDUM TO RFP

Redwood Coast Energy Authority Tree Removal for ACV Microgrid

Addendum #2 June 17, 2020

To All Prospective Respondents:

Redwood Coast Energy Authority (RCEA) herewith issues Addendum No. 1 to the above-referenced solicitation. This Addendum shall be made part of the Contract Documents and the proposer shall acknowledge receipt thereof in their Proposals. Except as specifically modified by this document, all other terms and conditions remain in full force and effect.

Question: Does the project require a certified arborist as the project manager or supervisor?

Answer: No. This project will not have a need for this aspect as there will be no concerns for tree health or root system health since all the trees are to be removed.

Question 2: Do the pine trees in contact with the fence line of Airport Road get removed?

Answer: No. Only the trees within the site will be removed.

Question 3: Per the scope of work, is it a requirement to top the trees?

Answer: No. There are no environmental constraints for dropping the trees as a whole. The only concern is for proper safety procedures to be followed and to protect property. Whatever is most economical and safe for contractor to remove the trees from the site will be acceptable.

Question 4: Can equipment be left outside the fence on Airport Road.?

Answer: No. All equipment must be brought into the site at the end of the day. The fence line must be kept secure meaning there should be clearance 15 feet from the fence for security.

Question 5: What is the mower deck height?

Answer: Mower deck height is approximately six inches

Question 6: Can equipment be used outside the fence on Airport Road?

Answer: Yes, as long as the contractor provides an encroachment permit from the county.

Question 7: As an option to reduce costs, rather than "cut flush", can the stumps be left tall in order to be visible to mowing operators?

Answer: For the base bid, contractors can leave stumps cut 24 inches above ground surface.

Question 8: What is the maximum stump height for "cut flush"?

Answer: See answer to Question 7. Please provide an Additive Alternate Bid Item for grinding stumps to be flush with surrounding ground surface. See revised bid form attached.

Question 9: If contractor chooses to broadcast woodchips, can the piles be flattened out later?

Answer: The piles of woodchips can be flattened out at the end of the job.

Question 10: Does the RFP include the old stumps and wood from earlier brush clearing work?

Answer: Please provide an Additive Alternate Bid Item to cut and ground old stumps and remove old downed wood from site. See revised bid form.

Question 11: Are the noble fir trees in the southwest corner included in the count?

Answer: Tree count was from topographical survey. All the trees in the area noted during the site walk are to be removed from the site. If a split trunk counts as two trees, they still need to be removed as part of the count.
