CONTRACTOR AND VENDOR NETWORK ENROLLMENT AND TERMS & CONDITIONS

INTRODUCTION

Redwood Coast Energy Authority (RCEA) is a Joint Powers Authority whose members include local governments in Humboldt County. Since 2003, RCEA has been serving Humboldt County businesses and residents with energy efficiency program services. Since 2017, RCEA has also been a Community Choice Aggregator (CCA) serving electric customers in Humboldt County. The purpose of the Redwood Coast Energy Authority is to develop and implement sustainable energy initiatives that reduce energy demand, increase energy efficiency, and advance the use of clean, efficient, and renewable resources available in the region.

RCEA's Demand Side Management provides a suite of energy efficiency and electrification services to our commercial, public, and residential customers by accessing local and state funding. In order to refer customers to installing contractors and vendors, RCEA has established a Contractor and Vendor Network. The Contractor and Vendor Network is a public-facing referral list for individual customers to find contractors for their installation needs or vendors for their equipment needs related to internal RCEA program services or external program referrals made by RCEA. RCEA programs of special interest to contractors and vendors are RCEA's Direct Install Incentive Program and Rebate Catalog Programs. These programs offer incentives or rebates to customers for the installation of energy efficient equipment which requires qualified equipment purchase and contractor installation. The Contractor Network is set to renew on November 30th of each year. RCEA reserves the right to terminate the program at any time.

Advantages to joining the RCEA Contractor and Vendor Network include:

- Inclusion in RCEA's Contractor and Vendor Network list that will be made available to customers
- Contractor and Vendor listings on the RCEA website at https://redwoodenergy.org/contractor-vendor-network/ including list of services offered, contact info, logo, and business description
- RCEA generates project leads through program outreach and No-Cost Assessments
- RCEA pregualifies and reserves rebates for customers
- Customers may assign their rebate to their installing contractor, allowing contractors to lower their upfront project cost
- RCEA has simple Terms and Conditions for enrollees
 - o RCEA does not require competitive bidding or job walks of Network Contractors
 - RCEA is not involved with pricing or contracts written by Network Contractors or Vendors
- RCEA Promotional materials are available to provide customers
- Assistance aligning RCEA incentives with contractor or vendor generated projects

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Submit the following to Shelly Reider by email addressed to sreider@redwoodenergy.org:

- 1. A completed and signed Contractor and Vendor Network Agreement (Exhibit A)
- 2. A completed and signed Enrollment Form, Contractors see Exhibit B and Vendors see Exhibit C.
- 3. Optional- You may also submit a file of your company logo for posting to the RCEA website.

Contractors and Vendors meeting enrollment requirements and all terms and conditions will be enrolled in RCEA's Contractor and Vendor Network.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Inclusion in RCEA's Contractor and Vendor Network is at RCEA's sole discretion. Any enrolled Contractor or Vendor may be removed at any time in RCEA's sole discretion.
- 2. An enrolled Contractor or Vendor may request removal from the Contractor and Vendor Network at any time by submitting written request to RCEA.
- 3. RCEA's Contractor and Vendor Network will be reviewed for renewal each year on November 30th. If RCEA extends the Contractor and Vendor Network, participants will be required to re-enroll to maintain inclusion in the Contractor and Vendor Network. RCEA maintains the right to extend the expiration date with written notification.
- 4. Contractor Applicant certifies they have the required licenses to perform the work they are soliciting and will provide copies to RCEA upon request.
- 5. Vendor Applicant certifies they have the required licenses for the sale of goods they are soliciting and will provide copies to RCEA upon request.
- Contractor Applicant will be expected to perform installations of energy efficient equipment related to the service types listed in their Enrollment Form within Humboldt County, CA. Contractors based outside Humboldt County must list their minimum requirements to serve Humboldt County customers.
- 7. Vendor Applicant will be expected to sell energy efficient equipment related to the service types listed in their Enrollment Form at customer project scale to customers within Humboldt County, CA.
- 8. For purposes of Open Enrollment 21-612, energy efficient equipment is defined as: qualified for any rebate or incentive offered by any RCEA program, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) programs, PG&E Third-Party programs; qualified for any energy efficiency financing product or program; or qualified for any state or federal tax incentive for energy efficiency or renewable energy. Applicants are encouraged to engage with RCEA prior to enrollment if they have questions whether equipment they install or sell meets the energy efficient equipment definition. The determination of whether the equipment installed or sold by the enrolled Network Contractor or Vendor meets the energy efficient equipment definition will be made by RCEA in its sole discretion.
- 9. RCEA reserves the right to update the installation service types and equipment service types at any time. RCEA will inform the entire Contractor Network if there are additional installation service types added and the entire Vendor Network if there are additional equipment types added. If existing Installation service types or equipment types are removed or edited, RCEA will notify only those contractors or vendors previously listed under those categories.
- 10. Ongoing application submissions will be accepted and reviewed monthly.
- 11. RCEA may choose to verify all certifications made and licenses, contact information, and website link provided in the Enrollment Form prior to Network enrollment. RCEA reserves the right to verify at any time that the enrolled Network Contractor or Vendor installs or sells energy efficient equipment (as defined in Section 8) and continues to meet all terms and conditions throughout the duration of the Contractor and Vendor Network.
- 12. Once enrolled, Network Contractors and Vendors may represent themselves as belonging to RCEA's Contractor and Vendor Network. However, **enrolled Contractors and Vendors may not represent**

themselves as an employee or representative of RCEA nor as an RCEA Installation Contractor Partner (unless applicant also holds Partner contract with RCEA). RCEA expressly prohibits cobranding by Network Contractors and Vendors in any format.

- 13. RCEA will not be a party to any installation contract between a customer and Network Contractor and will have no liability for a Network Contractor's performance under any installation contract.
- 14. RCEA will not be a party to the sale of goods to any customer by a Network Vendor and will have no liability for a Network Vendor's performance under any sales contract; and, RCEA makes no warranty, implied or express, about any goods sold by a Network Vendor.
- 15. Under no circumstance associated with this Open Enrollment 21-612 will RCEA owe a Network Contractor or Network Vendor funds for any purpose.
- 16. Only the service types listed on the Enrollment Forms are considered for this Open Enrollment 21-612. Please see RCEA's Contracting Opportunities webpage at https://redwoodenergy.org/contracting/ for additional opportunities.
- 17. RCEA will not accept Enrollment Forms through this Open Enrollment 21-612 for utility-scale energy project installations or equipment sales.
- 18. RCEA website listings of Network Contractors and Vendors will be limited to content provided in the Enrollment Form along with a high-resolution single logo image that will be reduced in size along with one link to enrolled Contractor or Vendor's website or media page.
- 19. RCEA reserves the right to display the service types for the Contractor and Vendor listing on the RCEA Website differently than depicted on the Enrollment Forms.
- 20. Enrollment in RCEA's Contractor and Vendor Network is not a guarantee of work or sales by RCEA.
- 21. All services performed by a Network Contractor or Vendor in association with the RCEA Contractor and Vendor Network must be in compliance with all laws, ordinances, codes, and regulations.
- 22. Each enrolled Contractor and Vendor, for itself and its heirs, successors and assigns (collectively, "Indemnifying Party"), agrees to release, defend, indemnify and hold harmless RCEA, and their respective officers, agents, volunteers and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, liability, damages, lawsuits or other actions, including, but not limited to, personal injury or death or property damage arising out of or in any way connected with the Indemnifying Party's operations or services provided, offered, or performed as a Network Contractor or Vendor, or of those of the Indemnifying Party's subcontractors or agents.
