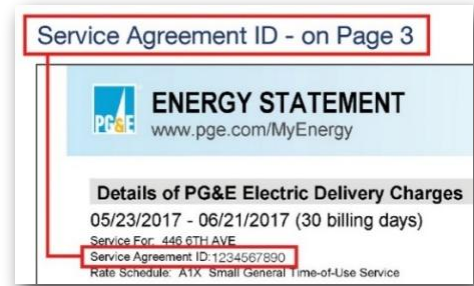

TERMS AND CONDITIONS Version 12/29/2025

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Customers eligible to receive an RCEA Electric Vehicle Charging Network Discount (“EV Charging Discount”) under RCEA’s Discount Public Electric Vehicle Charging Pilot Program (“Pilot Program”) must:
 - A. Be an existing RCEA Community Choice Energy (CCE) residential electricity customer account holder as of the date of application,
 - B. Submit a complete and properly completed application,
 - C. Own a light-duty Battery Electric Vehicle or Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicle - this includes vehicle weight classes 1 (6,000 pounds and less) and vehicle weight class 2 (6,001 to 10,000 pounds) - registered with the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) at the applicant’s RCEA service account address,
 - D. Be enrolled in one of PG&E’s discount programs (California Alternate Rates for Energy Program (CARE) or Family Electric Rate Assistance Program (FERA)); or, enrolled in any of the public assistance programs that demonstrate eligibility for PG&E’s CARE program listed in Attachment A: Qualifying Public Assistance Programs.
- 2. RESTRICTIONS:** Maximum of one EV Charging Discount per residential account service address (or unit number for multifamily residences with a shared electric account).
- 3. APPLICATION:** A complete application (“Complete Application Package”) must include all required information as detailed below, and any additional information or documentation that may be required by RCEA.
 - A. Applications must be signed by the Applicant. The Applicant must be the person identified in the RCEA Account Name as it appears on the electric bill. Assignment of EV Charging Discount may be made only by the Applicant to a resident of the household where the RCEA electric service is provided. RCEA will make a determination in its sole discretion whether a submitted application is complete. Failure to submit a Complete Application Package may result in delay or rejection of a filed application.
 - B. Requirements for a Complete Application Package:**
 - i. A completed and signed RCEA Discount Public EV Charging Application form.
 - ii. Copy of California DMV vehicle registration showing EV registered at the RCEA account address listed in the application.
 - iii. Proof of enrollment in public assistance program:
 - written proof of current enrollment in the PG&E CARE or FERA Program such as a copy of your current electric bill, or
 - written proof of current enrollment in one of the CARE Program’s qualifying public assistance programs.
- 4. EV CHARGING DISCOUNT:** The EV Charging Discount is a 40% discount on the current per kWh charging rate (“Discount Rate”) at an RCEA Network Charging Station. EV Charging Discounts will be issued to the recipient via an invitation to a “Connected Driver Account” within 30 business days following the submission of a Complete Application Package from an eligible and qualified applicant. Each EV Charging Discount recipient must have an established ChargePoint Account and follow instructions provided by RCEA to initiate a Connected Driver Account. Recipients must charge using the ChargePoint phone application or ChargePoint RFID card (available upon request by the ChargePoint account holder through the ChargePoint app) to receive the Discount Rate. Recipients may only use the EV Charging Discount to charge the EV registered at the RCEA account address. The EV Charging Discount is limited to one ChargePoint account, regardless of how many household members drive the EV. The EV Charging Discount will only apply the Discount Rate to charging fees (electricity dispensed), not to congestion (parking) fees or any other station fees.
- 5. PARTICIPATING ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS:** The EV Charging Discount is only available at public electric vehicle charging station locations managed by RCEA (“RCEA Network Charging Stations”). - 6. LIMITATIONS:** EV Charging Discounts are subject to funding availability; submittal of a completed application will not guarantee receipt of an EV Charging Discount. EV Charging Discounts will be issued on a first-come first-served basis until funding is depleted or the Pilot Program is terminated. At RCEA’s discretion, applicants placed on a waiting list may qualify for the EV Charging Discount if additional funds become available. RCEA reserves the right to deny an EV

Charging Discount to any individual deemed, in RCEA's sole discretion, to be violating the terms, conditions, and restrictions of the Pilot Program.

7. **DISPUTES:** Except where otherwise limited by law, RCEA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to make final determinations regarding any disputed issues about the Pilot Program, including but not limited to eligibility and EV Charging Discount rates.
8. **PROGRAM CHANGES:** RCEA reserves the right to change, modify, or terminate the Pilot Program at any time without any liability except as expressly stated herein.
9. **PROGRAM EXPIRATION:** The Pilot Program will expire upon the earliest to occur: (i) when funds are depleted, or (ii) when the Pilot Program is terminated by RCEA.
10. **DISCLAIMER:** RCEA makes no guarantee, representations, or warranties, expressed or implied, regarding the implementation or use of products purchased pursuant to this Pilot Program. Use of any product and acceptance of materials used is solely the customer's responsibility.
11. **CUSTOMER DISCLOSURE AUTHORIZATION:** By signing the RCEA Discount Public EV Charging Application form, the applicant confirms they are the service account holder of the account identified in the Application form, or authorized representative thereof, and authorize RCEA to disclose customer's name as a participant in the Pilot Program. Further, by signing the RCEA Discount Public EV Charging Application form, applicant confirms they have read and understand the Terms and Conditions listed above.
